SUMMARY

As part of the Manning Blvd Improvement Project a full inspection of every tree on Manning Blvd between Western Avenue and Washington Avenue was done and as a result the City of Albany will be removing 21 trees and replanting 39 trees.

TREE REMOVAL

After an inspection of trees within the boundaries of the Manning Blvd between Western & Washington Avenue and including the area defined as the Bridle path the following trees were identified as needing to be removed prior to the commencement of the project. The list of trees is listed below with additional information included. This information includes the type of tree, size of tree and reason for removal.
