Common Council Declares the Week of June 19 as 518 Black Restaurant Week

ALBANY, NY –The Albany Common Council on June 5 declared the week of June 19 as 518 Black Restaurant Week. Part of a nationwide invitation to support Black-owned restaurants during Juneteenth, the event is designed to recognize the contributions of Black chefs, restaurateurs and food-industry professionals in the City of Albany and across the Capital Region.
