What to know about Garbage & Recycling

 DGS does not supply you with a trash can. You can purchase a trash can at your local hardware store, (ie Home Depot, Lowes, Walmart etc.) It shall have a maximum volume of 50 gallons and be fitted with a lid.

 DGS will provide you a recycling bin or cart. Email albanyrecycles@albanyny.gov or call (518) 434-2489.


 DGS provides 8 trips from the curb of trash weekly. This includes bulk trash. If an item requires 2 people to pick it up it is considered to 2 trips.

 Bulk trash is defined as (household furniture, mattresses, toilets etc) and may be placed at the curb in limited quantities. Please call Neighborhood Services at (518) 434-2489 at least 24 hours prior to your collection day to inform them of these items. For a complete list of bulk trash items visit albanynyrecycles.com and select garbage collection or scan the QR code.

 White goods (Air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, stoves, hot water tanks, tires) can be placed curbside. Please call Neighborhood Services at (518) 434-2489 at least 24 hours prior to your collection day to inform them of these items. For a complete list of white good items visit albanynyrecycles.com and select garbage collection or scan the QR code.

 Parking permits and handicap parking placards can be obtained at City Hall. For rules & regulations visit albanyny.gov/760/Parking-Permits or scan the QR code.


