Smoke Alarms

Fire Safety Tips...

- ◊ Install smoke alarms both inside and outside of every sleeping area and on every level of your home.
- ◊ Install smoke alarms on the ceiling or wall, at least 4" from corners OR according to manufacturer's instructions.
- ◊ Replace any smoke alarm that is more than 10 years old.
- ◊ Test smoke alarms monthly, in addition to making sure that the detector is working properly, this also familiarizes your family to the sound of the alarm.
- ◊ Make sure to change the alkaline batteries twice a year—a good rule of thumb is to change the batteries when changing your clocks.
- ◊ A "chirping" sound from your alarm means the battery is low and needs to be changed.
- ◊ Consider purchasing a lithium powered detector, which may last up to ten years with no battery change.
- ◊ If your smoke alarm sounds during cooking DO NOT disable the smoke alarm or take the batteries out—press the hush button if the smoke alarm has one.
- ◊ Make sure that everyone knows to go directly to the meeting place outside of the home when the alarm sounds and call the fire department from a neighbor's phone. Once out, stay out!

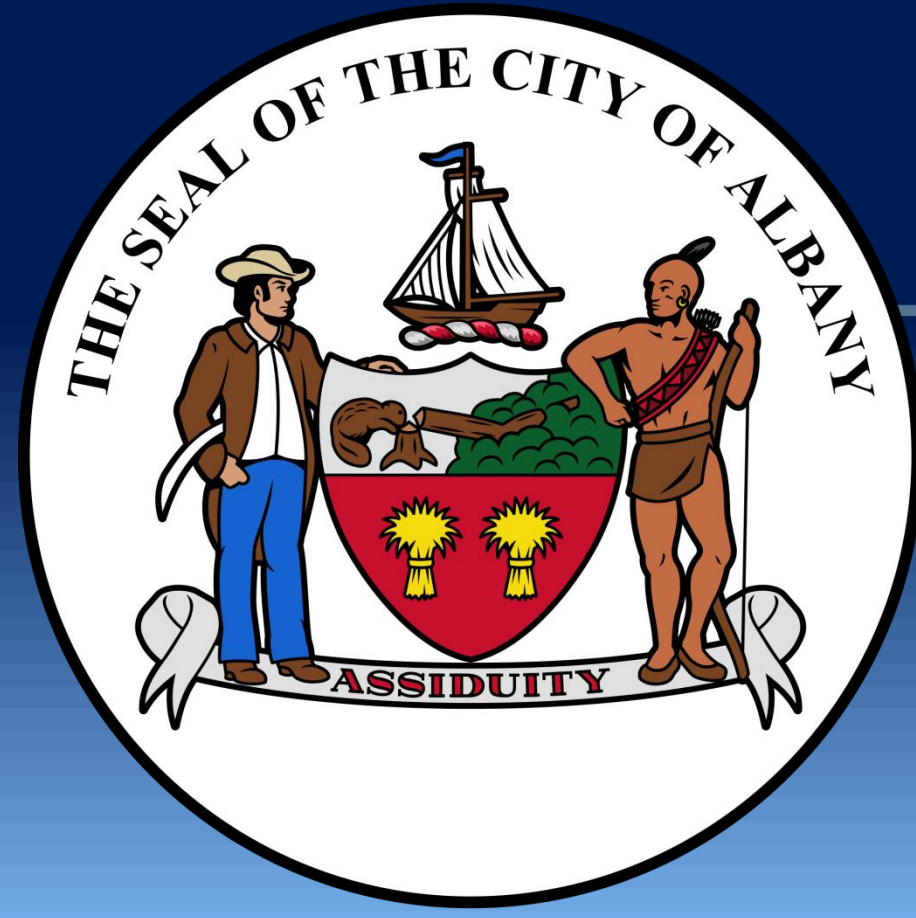


Figure 2. Average Graduation Rates of SYEP Participants and Non-Participants by GPA Percentile
